



2022 SHELTER RENTAL INFORMATION

Shelters at Avalon Park may be rented by contacting the Avalon Borough Administration Office at 412-761-5820, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Reservations will be accepted beginning in January of the current year you wish to use the shelters. For 2022, we will begin accepting reservations on Monday, January 3.

Rental Dates for 2022: *May 1 to October 2*

All Shelter Rentals require a Security Deposit of \$50 in addition to the Shelter Rental Fee

SHELTER 1:

- Permit Required.
- Full Kitchen – includes full size refrigerator, stove/oven, additional 4-burner gas cook top, grill, hot water.
- Seats approximately 50 people.
- Residents - \$175.00/Non-Residents - \$200.00

SHELTER 2:

- Permit Required.
- No kitchen facilities. Does include electric and grills.
- Seats approximately 100 people.
- All rentals \$135.00

SHELTER 3:

- This shelter is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- No reservations or permit required.
- No amenities other than picnic tables.

GENERAL RULES

- Alcohol is permitted with a completed Malt Beverage and Wine Permit Application and non-refundable \$100 fee.
- Rental fees must be *paid in full* within 2 weeks (10 business days) after making your reservation.
- ID required for proof of residency.
- \$50.00 security deposit will be returned provided the shelter is left in satisfactory condition. Renter must request refund within 30 days of rental.
- ½ off shelter rentals for 501(c)3 non-profit organizations.
- Cancellations must be made 2 weeks or 10 business days before your event to receive a full refund. After this period, there is a \$25.00 fee to cancel a reservation and receive your shelter rental fee refund.
- Special pool rates (\$5.00/person) are available with shelter rentals. Wristbands are required to obtain this special rate. Please make arrangements at the time of your shelter rental or prior to your event. **Wristbands must be purchased at the Administration Office and will not be sold at the pool entrance gate the day of your event.**
