WEEKLY GARBAGE COLLECTION: A limit of five metal or plastic cans no larger than 33 gallons with lids. Garbage & rubbish means all refuse and animal matter and vegetable matter which has been used for food for man and intended to be so used. All putrescible material, food containers, broken glass, dishes and crockery, plastic bottles, all paper cartons, tied newspapers and magazines; clothing and leather goods, coat hangers, small toys, cooking utensils, ashes in metal containers, packaging, empty paint cans, discarded mail; trunks, household appliances with the Freon removed, furniture, mattresses and springs; tree, hedge and brush cuttings bundled in 24" lengths and general household refuse. Summer grass clippings – 1 bag of clippings to 1 bag of garbage.

BI-WEEKLY RECYCLABLE COLLECTION: Recycling bins are available at the Borough Office for \$10.00. Only in these bins will the following recyclables be collected: non-shiny newspaper (bagged in plastic), aluminum and bi-metal (label removed); clear and colored glass placed unbroken in bin; no light bulbs, pyrex, ceramics or window glass will be collected.

AUTUMN LEAF COLLECTION: The Avalon Borough Crew will be responsible for the Fall leaf collection. Residents are asked to rake leaves into a pile on the street in front of their homes for pickup. Leaves may also be bagged and left at the curb for pickup.

THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE DOES NOT APPLY TO APARTMENT BUILDINGS OR MORE THAN 3-FAMILY DWELLINGS:

ALL TRASH & RECYCLABLES WILL BE COLLECTED ON THURSDAY, EXCEPT FOR THE HOLIDAYS NOTED BELOW. THESE HOLIDAYS WILL MOVE THE COLLECTION FORWARD ONE DAY TO FRIDAY.

No refuse will be taken that is caused by repairs, alterations of residences, new construction of buildings, sidewalks, no bricks, earth, broken stones, concrete or sand. No automobile parts or tires will be collected.

Rubbish must be placed at the front curb no later than 5:00 am nor more than 24 hours prior to collection. Rubbish collectors will not enter yards or homes for pickup.

Borough Ordinance #1214 states that dirt, snow, ice and debris of any kind must be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after the accumulation thereof.
