ORDINANCE NO. 1097

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF AVALON POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL COOPERATION AND ENFORCEMENT CONTRACT WITH THE KILBUCK TOWNSHIP/BEN AVON HEIGHTS BOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Avalon Borough Police Department is desirous of entering into a joint cooperation and enforcement agreement with the Kilbuck Township/Ben Avon Heights Borough Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the authority to permit the execution of such an agreement is vested in the Council of the Borough of Avalon in conjunction with the Mayor of the Borough of Avalon; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Avalon in conjunction with the Mayor of the Borough of Avalon, after due investigation and deliberation, have deemed it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the Borough of Avalon to permit the Avalon Borough Police Department to cooperate with the Kilbuck Township/Ben Avon Heights Borough Police Department in the enforcement of the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the respective Ordinances of the municipalities herein involved.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby resolved by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Avalon Borough Police Department be and is hereby authorized to cooperate with the Kilbuck Township/Ben Avon Heights Borough Police Department in the enforcement of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Ordinances of the Borough of Avalon, the Township of Kilbuck and the Borough of Ben Avon Heights.

SECTION 2: That the Council of the Borough of Avalon with the knowledge and consent of the Mayor of the Borough

have hereby authorized the proper officers and officials to execute a contract setting forth the rights, duties and obligations of the Avalon Borough Police Department and the Kilbuck Township/Ben Avon Heights Borough Police Department.

SECTION 3: That the Council of the Borough of Avalon with the knowledge and consent of the Mayor of the Borough of Avalon does hereby direct that the agreement referred to herein shall in no way adversely affect the police coverage of the Borough of Avalon.

SECTION 4: That any Ordinance or part of Ordinance conflicting with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.
