ORDINANCE NO. 1099

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1046 OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON AND IN PARTICULAR SECTION 2 INVOLVING RATES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same that:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1046 of the Borough of Avalon shall be amended to read as follows:

"The rates to be assessed will be as follows:

CONNECTION CHARGES

Connection of Initial Outlet	\$15.00
Connection of Additional Outlet at a Time Other than Connection of Initial Outlet	\$15.00
Relocation or Re-Arrangement of Outlets at Customer's Request	\$15.00
Reconnection After Disconnection for any reason	\$10.00

MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGES

Residential Rates:

First Outlet	\$ 5.50
Additional Outlet	\$ 1.25

Commercial Rates:

First Outlet	\$ 7.00
Additional Outlet	\$ 1.25

Motels, hotels, rooming houses, apartment houses, other multiunit dwellings, trailer courts, hospitals and rest homes shall be on a negotiated rate. The Company will provide signal at no charge to outlets in any one room in each public and parochial school, each police station, each Borough Building, each firehouse, where requested, in the cabled area in the Borough of Avalon.

The Company shall at all times be limited in its maximum charges, fees and rates for its services pursuant to this Ordinance, as heretofore provided, unless prior approval to increase such charges, fees and rates is granted by Borough Council by amendment to this ordinance."

SECTION 2: This amendment to Ordinance No. 1046 shall take effect the 1st day of June, 1976.

SECTION 3: The rate changes as proposed by this amendment are contingent upon the written acceptance of said rate changes by the Company (Centre Video Corporation). Failure to receive written acceptance shall constitute a rejection and the original rates as stated in Ordinance 1046 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Any ordinance or part of any ordinance inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and they hereby are repealed.
