ORDINANCE NO. 1102

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTIONS 2 AND 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 834 OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON BY AMENDING THE PARKING FEES, PARKING FEES AND CERTAIN PARKING METER SPACES IN THE BOROUGH OF AVALON.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 834 be amended to read as follows:

"Section 2: After the installation of parking meters, it shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle or any vehicle to park such vehicle between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. on any day upon positions on either side of California Avenue designated as Parking Meter Zones, where parking meters have been installed, except Sundays and the following Holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas.

Meters known and designated as Nos. 21 through and including 35 and Nos. 50 through and including 59, installed in the 500 block of California Avenue, will be subject to the same hours and terms listed above on Mondays through Fridays, only, but these meters shall not be operative or subject to fines or penalties imposed herein on Saturdays, Sundays and the Holidays above listed.

The parking of any motor vehicle or any vehicle in any part of California Avenue, whether in a Parking Meter Zone or elsewhere, shall be subject to the

provisions of the Street Sweeping Ordinance No.

1070, and to emergencies or special events such as parades, according to authority of the Mayor and Chief of Police of Avalon.

The parking of any motor vehicle or any vehicle in any part of California Avenue not designated as a Parking Meter Zone, shall be limited to such parking time as has been fixed by other ordinances of the Borough of Avalon."

SECTION 2: That Section 4 of Ordinance no. 834 be amended to read as follows:

"Section 4: In order that Police Officers or persons designated by Borough Council to patrol meters may properly compute the time during which a vehicle is parked, the owner or operator of said vehicle shall, upon entering such parking space, during the time of limited parking, immediately deposit a five cent (\$.05) coin of the United States in the Parking Meter situated at the side of said parking space, and operate the timing mechanism of the Parking Meter according to instructions thereon.

For convenience of persons not having a five cent (\$.05) coin, a ten cent (\$.10) coin may be substituted. Only one hour of time will be registered on the Parking Meter, either for a five cent (\$.05) coin or a ten cent (\$.10) coin. Parking Meters shall include instructions as follows:

'1 HOUR FOR 1 NICKEL  
FOR CONVENIENCE  
1 HOUR FOR 1 DIME'

placing the meter in operation, the parking space may be lawfully occupied by such vehicle during the period of time which has been prescribed for the particular amount deposited. The Parking Meters, when properly operated, shall be so adjusted that coins may be deposited at any time throughout the marked range of the meters and the lawful time availability restored to the maximum period of sixty (60) minutes. If such vehicle shall remain parked in any such parking space for such length of time that the meter shall indicate by a proper signal that the lawful parking period has expired, such vehicle shall be considered as parking overtime, and the parking of a vehicle overtime shall be a violation of this ordinance."

SECTION 3: Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
