ORDINANCE NO. 1121

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALARIES OF THE POLICEMEN AND POLICE OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON ORDINANCES REGULATING THE NUMBER OF POLICE AND POLICE OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

Effective January 1, 1979, the

Borough of Avalon shall fix the salaries of police and police officers for the calendar year January 1, 1979 to December 31, 1979 as follows:

| (d) Patrolman of police force with six (6) months of service or less   | 13,706.00    |

SECTION II.

All Ordinances of the Borough of

Avalon regulating the number of policemen and police officers within the Borough of Avalon be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
