ORDINANCE NO. 1126

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 614, CHANGING THE ESTABLISHED GRADE OF PEACH STREET FROM BIRMINGHAM AVENUE TO LOCUST STREET, AND CONTINUING THE GRADE OF PEACH ALLEY FROM LOCUST STREET TO PROSPECT STREET AS ESTABLISHED IN ORDINANCE NO. 614.

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same that the grade of the center line of Peach Street is hereby amended and established as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 1: SECTION 1 of Ordinance No. 614 shall be amended to read as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Easterly side of Birmingham Avenue at an elevation of 818.00 feet above Borough Datum, thence rising at the rate of 6.59 feet per 100 feet for a distance of 326.64 feet to a point of curve at an elevation of 840.16 feet; thence falling by a convex vertical curve for a distance of 100 feet to the point of tangent at an elevation of 838.66 feet, thence falling at the rate of 9.59 feet per 100 feet for a distance of 215.22 feet to a point at an elevation of 818.00 feet at the west side line of Locust Street.

SECTION 2: The grade and center line of Peach Alley from the Easterly side line of Locust Street to Prospect Street as established in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 614 shall not be changed by this Ordinance and shall remain as previously established.

SECTION 3: That any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
