ORDINANCE NO. 1140

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALARIES OF THE POLICEMEN AND POLICE OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON ORDINANCES REGULATING THE NUMBER OF POLICE AND POLICE OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: Effective January 1, 1982, the Borough of Avalon shall fix the salaries of police and police officers for the calendar year January 1, 1982 to December 31, 1982 and for calendar years from January 1, 1982 to December 31, 1982 as follows:

	<u>1982</u>
(a) Chief of Police	\$24,484.00
(b) Lieutenant of Police	\$22,504.80
(c) Patrolman of police force with more than six (6) months of service	\$20,850.08
(d) Patrolman of police force with six (6) months of service or less	\$17,506.31

SECTION II: Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
