ORDINANCE NO. 1144

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1070, INCREASING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 1070.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 1070 entitled an Ordinance regulating the movement, operation, and parking of vehicles on certain streets and alleys of the Borough enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, Article VI, Section 1, entitled Penalties, should be amended.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 1070, Article VI, Section 1 entitled Penalties should be amended to read as follows:

"Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance or aiding, abetting, or assisting in the violation of said provisions should, upon violation of said provisions, be fined the sum of \$2.00 if paid within seven (7) days of said violation. If not paid within seven (7) days of the violation and upon conviction thereof before a District Magistrate, violator shall be fined the sum of \$10.00 and costs of prosecution. Upon default of payment or upon failure to pay the fine and costs, the violator shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding 10 days."

Section 3: Any Ordinance or part thereof, insofar only as the same conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

This Ordinance ordained and enacted into a Law in Council this 21ST day of April, 1982.
