ORDINANCE NO. 1145

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 860 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1116 INCREASING THE PENALTIES AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 860.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same.

Section 1: Ordinance No. 1116 was passed amending Ordinance No. 860, and Ordinance No. 860, Section 5, should be amended increasing the penalties set forth therein.

Section 2: Section 5 of Ordinance No. 860 should be amended to read as follows:

"Any person, firm, or corporation, violating the provisions of this Ordinance or aiding, abetting, or assisting in the violation of said provisions should, upon violation of said provisions, be fined the sum of \$10.00 if paid within seven (7) days of said violation. If not paid within seven (7) days of the violation and upon conviction thereof before a District Magistrate, violator shall be fined the sum of \$20.00 and costs of prosecution. Upon default of payment or upon failure to pay the fine and costs, the violator shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding 10 days."

Section 3: Any Ordinance or part thereof, insofar only as the same conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
