ORDINANCE NO. 1173

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1100 INCREASING THE PENALTIES UNDER SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE OF NO. 1100.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1100 shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 7: Any owner of a dog or cat who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars or in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding three (3) days.

SECTION 2: Any Ordinance or parts of any Ordinance inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
