AVALON BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 1208

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1017, AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH MANAGER OR THE AVALON BOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT TO REMOVE ACCUMULATIONS OF GARBAGE, DEBRIS, ETC., AFTER NOTICE, AND THE EXPENSE AT THE COST OF THE OWNER, OCCUPANT OR LESSEE: PROHIBITING THE THROWING OR SWEEPING, OR DEPOSIT IN ANY MANNER, OF ASHES, RUBBISH, TIN CANS, GARBAGE, OR OTHER DEBRIS OF ANY KIND ONTO PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES, INTO GUTTERS, OR INTO SEWERS, OR ONTO PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Section II of Ordinance No. 1017 shall be amended to read as follows:

No owner, lessee or occupant of any building shall throw, scatter or permit the accumulation of any debris, ashes, garbage, waste paper, household waste, rubbish, metal, refuse materials or any other dangerous or detrimental substance on any sidewalks or thoroughfares abutting the building, in yards, in open garages, on porches or on grounds or curtilage forming any part of the premises.

Debris shall include ashes, garbage, waste paper, household waste, rubbish, metal, refuse materials, car parts, tires and rims, discarded refrigerators, television sets and tubes, hot water heaters and tanks, furnaces and appliances, glass, pieces of concrete, wood or other building materials, stacks of newspapers or any other dangerous or detrimental substance.

SECTION 2: Section IV of Ordinance No. 1017 shall be amended to read as follows:

An owner who is not in actual possession of any premises described in Sections 2 and 3 hereof, is hereby required to remove, or cause to be removed, all debris, ashes, garbage, waste paper, rubbish, metal, refuse materials or any other dangerous or detrimental substances as prohibited by this Ordinance within seventy-two (72) hours of accumulation or abandonment.

SECTION 3: Section VII of Ordinance No. 1017 shall be amended to read as follows:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be administered by the

Borough Manager or the Avalon Borough Police Department. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be subject to a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollar for each offense, shall be recovered by the District Magistrate of the Borough of Avalon, and, in default of payment thereof in such violations, shall be subject to a jail term for a period not to exceed Thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4: Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance shall be and is hereby repealed to the extent of conflict to give this Ordinance full force and effect.
