ORDINANCE NO. 1210

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1155; AND SECTION I OF ORDINANCE NO. 1203 DECREASING THE PAYMENT OF CHARGES IMPOSED FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ALL GARBAGE AND HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH AND RECYCLABLES IN THE BOROUGH OF AVALON.

WHEREAS, due to the decreased cost of removal and disposal of all household rubbish and recyclables in the Borough of Avalon, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Council of the Borough of Avalon has found it necessary to decrease the payment of such charges imposed on each residential dwelling owner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

(1) SECTION VIII OF ORDINANCE NO. 1155; SECTION I OF ORDINANCE NO. 1203 shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION VIII.

(1) Each residential dwelling unit owner shall be charged the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per unit for the services rendered for the year 1994 and a like and equal sum for each year thereafter, unless amended by Ordinance or repealed by Ordinance.

(a) Any unit owner making payment in full on or before February 28, 1994 shall receive a Ten (10%) Percent discount.

(b) The full yearly service charge shall be due and payable on or before June 30 1994.

(c) All payments made after June 30, 1994 shall be subject to a Ten (10%) Percent penalty.

(2) Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance No. 1155 and No. 1203 conflicting with or inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
