ORDINANCE NO. 1220

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 834 AND 1168 INCREASING THE PENALTIES THEREOF.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: Section 8 of Ordinance 834, also Section 1 of Ordinance 1168, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance or aiding, abetting, or assisting in the violation of said provisions should, upon violation of said provisions, be fined the sum of \$4.00 if paid within seven (7) days of said violation; the sum of \$15.00 if paid within eight (8) to fifteen (15) days of said violation; and the sum of \$25.00 if paid within sixteen (16) to twenty-five (25) days of said violation. If not paid within twenty-five (25) days of the violation and upon conviction thereof before a District Magistrate, violator shall be fined the sum of \$25.00 and costs of prosecution. Upon default of payment or upon failure to pay the fine and costs, the violator shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding ten (10) days."

Section 2: Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
