ORDINANCE NO 1234

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF FISK AVENUE AND ORCHARD AVENUE, IN THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, IN A NORTH AND SOUTH DIRECTION, SO THAT SAID INTERSECTION WILL NOW CONSTITUTE A FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTION.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted with the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: Stop Intersection.

Upon enactment, the intersection of Fisk Avenue and Orchard Avenue, in a north and south direction, is hereby established as stop intersection, and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position upon the first named street as to face traffic approaching the second-named street in the direction or directions indicated. Every driver of a vehicle approaching any such intersection upon the first named street, in the direction or directions indicated in each case, shall come to a full stop before entering any such intersection.

Section 2: Four-Way Stop Intersection.

It is the intent of this Ordinance to make Fisk Avenue at Orchard Avenue a four-way stop intersection.

Section 3: Repealer.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective when it is recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Borough.


