BOROUGH OF AVALON
ORDINANCE NO. 1260

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, AND COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE
ON THE WEST SIDE OF UNION AVENUE BETWEEN
SEDALIA AVENUE AND NEW BRIGHTON ROAD;
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF;
AND REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

SECTION 1: ENACTING CLAUSE.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the following Ordinance shall be in full force and effect in the Borough of Avalon.

SECTION 2: PROHIBITED PARKING AT ALL TIMES.

Parking shall be prohibited at all times at the following locations and the Borough of Avalon is authorized to erect traffic control devices prohibiting parking at such locations:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Union Avenue	West	Sedalia Avenue and New Brighton Road

SECTION 3: VALIDITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its provisions or any part of any provision shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise held to be invalid, the decision of the Court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions. It is hereby declared to be the intent of Borough

Council that this Ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional provisions or parts thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 4. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

Any person that violates Section 2 of this Ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15.00 and costs of prosecution.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon the erection of no parking traffic control devices on Union Avenue.
