

BOROUGH OF AVALON

ORDINANCE NO 1265

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF UNION AVENUE BETWEEN CHESTER AVENUE AND NEW BRIGHTON ROAD IN THE BOROUGH OF AVALON; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

Section 1: Enacting Clause.

Be it ordained and enacted by Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the following Ordinance shall be in full force and effect in the Borough of Avalon.

Section 2: Prohibited Parking At All Times.

Parking shall be prohibited at all times at the following locations and the Borough of Avalon is authorized to erect traffic control devices prohibiting parking at such locations:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Union Avenue	West	Chester Avenue and New Brighton Road

Section 3: Validity.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its provisions or any part of any provision shall be held to be unenforceable, unconstitutional or otherwise held to be invalid, the decision of the Court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough of Avalon that this Ordinance would have been enacted even if such unconstitutional provision or part thereof had not been included herein.

Section 4: Violations and Penalties.

Any person who violates Section 2 of this Ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay of fine of not more than \$15.00 and costs of prosecution.

Section 5: Repealer.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 6: Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall become effective when it is recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Borough and upon the erection of no parting traffic control devices on Union Avenue.
