

BOROUGH OF AVALON

ORDINANCE NO. 1267

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE OFFICES OF BOROUGH MANAGER, BOROUGH SECRETARY AND BOROUGH TREASURER TO BE HELD BY THE SAME PERSON; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

Whereas, the Act of February 1, 1966, No. 581, § 1143, 53 P.S. § 46143 ordains that the offices of borough manager, borough secretary and borough treasurer shall not be incompatible and any two or more or all of said offices may be held by one person; and

Whereas, the Act of March 28, 1990, P.L. 82, No. 18, § 1, 53 P.S. § 46104 ordains that the offices of borough secretary and borough treasurer may be held by the same person when so authorized by ordinance; and

Whereas, it is the desire of Borough Council to authorize by Ordinance that the offices of borough manager, borough secretary and borough treasurer to be held by the same person; and

Whereas, it is the desire of Borough Council, that because of the vast municipal experience of past Council President Harry W. Dilmore, President of Borough Council for fourteen (14) years, Councilman on Borough Council for twenty-five (25) years and former Chairman of the Avalon Borough Revitalization Committee, that Harry W.

Dilmore be appointed borough manager, borough secretary and borough treasurer and that all of said offices be held by one person.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Avalon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the following Ordinance shall be in full force and effect in the Borough of Avalon.

SECTION 1: OFFICES OF BOROUGH MANAGER, BOROUGH SECRETARY AND BOROUGH TREASURER COMPATIBLE.

The offices of borough manager, borough secretary and borough treasurer are hereby declared to be compatible in the Borough of Avalon.

SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION OF OFFICES OF BOROUGH MANAGER, BOROUGH SECRETARY AND BOROUGH TREASURER TO BE HELD BY SAME PERSON.

The Borough of Avalon is hereby authorized to appoint the same person in the Borough of Avalon to hold the offices of borough manager, borough secretary and borough treasurer.

SECTION 3: APPOINTMENT OF HARRY W. DILMORE, BOROUGH MANAGER, BOROUGH SECRETARY AND BOROUGH TREASURER.

Harry W. Dilmore is hereby appointed Borough Manager, Borough Secretary and Borough Treasurer for the Borough of Avalon.

SECTION 4: VALIDITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its provisions or any part of any provision shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise held to be invalid, the decision of the Court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions. It is hereby declared to be the intent of Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional provisions or parts thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective when recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Borough of Avalon.


