**RESOLUTION NO. 1018 of 2005**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA SETTING FORTH THE MAXIMUM GENTRIFICATION REBATE FOR 2006 IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS PURSUANT TO TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 1292.**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Avalon has established a program of property tax relief as mandated by Act 77, the Allegheny County Regional Asset District Law, 16 P.S. § 6101-B et seq., for longtime senior citizen owner/occupants of personal residences as well as for certain widows and widowers and permanently disabled persons in the Borough of Avalon pursuant to Borough Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_ established that eligible taxpayers are entitled to claim a partial rebate of Avalon Borough property taxes beginning in 2006 in an amount determined by the percentage factor set forth in the Senior Citizens Rebate and Assistance Act, the maximum rebate of which shall not exceed the amount set forth annually by Resolution of the Borough Council of the Borough of Avalon.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by Borough Council of the Borough of Avalon, and it is hereby resolved with the authority of same:

SECTION 1: The maximum rebate to eligible taxpayers under the Avalon Borough Senior Citizen Tax Rebate Ordinance for 2006 is set in the amount of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars.

SECTION 2: The proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to rebate to eligible taxpayers an amount not to exceed such amount in 2006.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be effective for fiscal year 2006 and each subsequent year thereafter until repealed or amended by a subsequent Resolution.

SECTION 4: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions conflicting herewith are repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.
