RESOLUTION NO. 810

BOROUGH OF AVALON

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RECOMMENDATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS TO CREATE A REGIONAL POLICE FORCE BETWEEN BOROUGH OF AVALON AND BELLEVUE TO APPOINT AN IMPLEMENTATION STUDY TEAM FOR SAID PURPOSE

WHEREAS, AVALON hereinafter "Borough", has previously appointed representative to a Joint Study Commission with representatives of Bruce Tindle and Edward Klicker to consider the feasibility of alternative police protection services and that Commission has recommended the creation of a Regional Police Force to serve the TWO (2) municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Borough is authorized to establish a Joint Implementation Study Team with said municipality(s) for the purpose of implementing and taking steps to create a Regional Police Force under Section 5 of Article IX of the Pennsylvania Constitution, the Inter-Governmental Cooperation Act, 53. P.S. S481, et seq, Section 1202 of the Borough Code and reported case law involving creation of regional police forces.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Borough does hereby accept the recommendation(s) presented by the Department of Community Affairs to create a Regional Police Force between the Borough of Avalon and the Borough of Bellevue and to appoint TWO (2) representatives to an implementation study team for the purpose of doing all things necessary to create and establish said Regional Police Force.
2. That, by these present, there is hereby established the "Joint Implementation Study Team" consisting of representatives from each of the following participating municipalities: Borough of Avalon Borough of Bellevue.
3. That the role of the Study Team shall be to carry on the completed study and work of the previously established Joint Police Study and to: (1) determine the specific procedure to be employed in formally creating a Regional Police Force; (2) appoint consultants to assist in the implementation phase; (3) advertise and undertake interviewing process for selection of Chief of Police position; (4) authorize the municipal solicitors to commence work on a proposed Regional Police Force Agreement; and (5) appoint sub-committees to assist in the work of the Team and generally to do all things necessary to implement and prepare for the formal creation

and establishment of a Regional Police Force for the participating municipalities.

4. That Borough authorizes the cash expenditure of
 \$0.00 to the Implementation Study Team towards initial and continuing administrative expenses. Each municipality shall contribute a like amount and all costs of the Study Team shall be borne equally by the participating municipalities.
5. That the Implementation Study Team shall serve in the capacity of an advisory board only and the participating municipalities shall not be bound by the findings and/or recommendations of the Team. The Team shall have no authority to expend monies nor occur debut whatsoever without prior approval of the governing bodies of the participating municipalities.


