RESOLUTION NO. 827

WHEREAS, the Borough of Avalon experienced severe winter weather in January, 1994, causing Borough streets and highways to become extremely dangerous for travel by the residents and emergency vehicles; and

WHEREAS, due to restrictive funds and manpower, it was necessary and in the public interest that assistance be requested from Allegheny County, and;

WHEREAS, Allegheny County Emergency Operation Center, at the request of Allegheny County Commissioner, Tom Foerster, did lend its support in snow removal, in the form of manpower and equipment, to help make Borough streets safe and passable for the residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, it is the pleasure and duty of the Council of the Borough of Avalon, on its own behalf, as well as on behalf of all the citizens of the Borough, to recognize the efforts and deeds of Commissioner Foerster and the Allegheny County Emergency Operation Center.
