RESOLUTION NO. 829

WHEREAS, the Borough of Avalon experienced severe winter weather in January, 1994, causing Borough streets and highways to become extremely dangerous for travel by the residents and emergency vehicles; and

WHEREAS, due to restrictive funds and manpower, it was necessary and in the public interest that assistance be requested from Allegheny County, and;

WHEREAS, Allegheny County Emergency Operation Center, at the request of Allegheny County Commissioner, Larry Dunn, did lend its support in snow removal, in the form of manpower and equipment, to help make Borough streets safe and passable for the residents of the Borough; and
