OFFICIAL RESOLUTION NO. 914

WHEREAS, on March 1, 1999, Allegheny County began its 25th Year as a participant in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program which funds a myriad of infrastructure improvement, social service, economic development, and housing programs in Allegheny County, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Avalon Borough hereby petitions the U.S. Congress and Administration to recognize the outstanding work being done locally and nationally by the Community Development Block Grant Program, and of its vital importance to the community and to the people who live in its lower income neighborhoods, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be conveyed to the appropriate elected official and appointed officials of the Federal government and that Avalon Borough's name be added to the roll of those committed to the preservation and full funding the Community Development Block Grant Program and maintenance of its essential features over the course of the next session of Congress.
