RESOLUTION NO. 956

WHEREAS, Neville Island industries emit roughly 25% of the toxic chemical releases for Allegheny County,

WHEREAS, the Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) has proposed permits for over 81 tons per year in new chemical emissions from Neville Island area plants in the past year, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of both the community and business to reduce toxic chemical emissions,

The Borough of Avalon, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves that:

Allegheny County should, in a timely manner, pass The Environmental Fairness and Pollution Prevention Act, the provisions of which will:

- 1) prevent the ACHD from issuing permits for facility expansion for those plants which are not in compliance with current permits, 2) require the ACHD to assess the cumulative impact of nearby air pollution sources and, 3) evaluate the applicant's pollution prevention controls prior to issuing new permits.


Copies of this resolution will be sent to James Roddey, Allegheny County Executive and the members of Allegheny County Council.
