RESOLUTION NO. 980

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF AVALON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IS IN SUPPORT OF LEGISLATION TO INCREASE THE PREVAILING WAGE EXEMPTION.

WHEREAS, the prevailing wage exemption has been \$25,000 since 1963; and


WHEREAS, the prevailing wage exemption for the year 2003 would be approximately \$150,000 if escalated by the consumer price index for the years from 1963 to 2003; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 612, which addresses an increase of \$150,000 in the prevailing wage exemption limit as well as the incorporation of a yearly escalator clause, has been recently introduced and is presently under consideration, and

WHEREAS, QVCOG has passed a motion to support the concept of an increase in the Prevailing wage exemption and also the concept of an escalator clause.


THEREFORE, the Council of the BOROUGH OF AVALON, herein declares its support for enactment of House Bill 612 providing for an increase to \$150,000 in the prevailing wage exemption and incorporating an escalator to ensure an appropriate prevailing wage exemption for future years.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, this 15th day of April, 2003.


